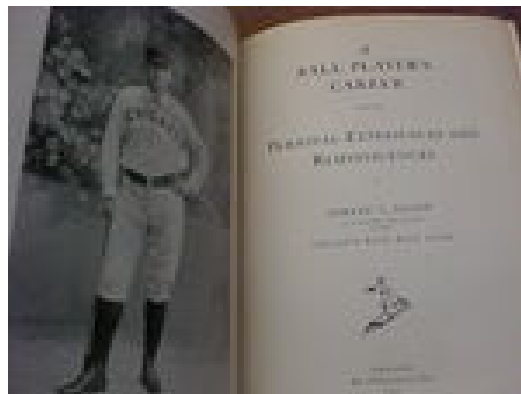

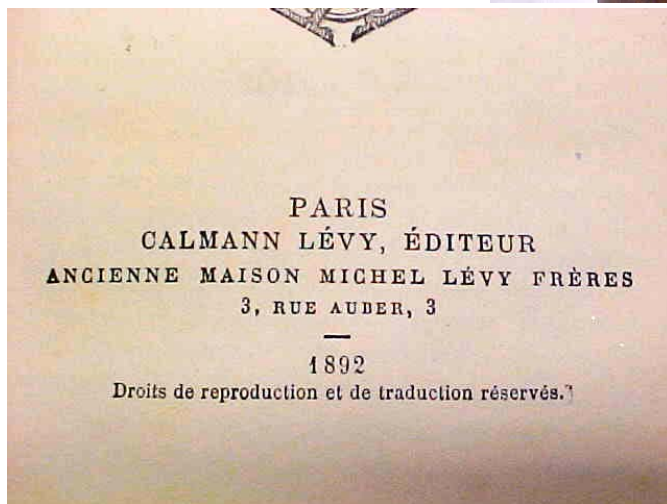
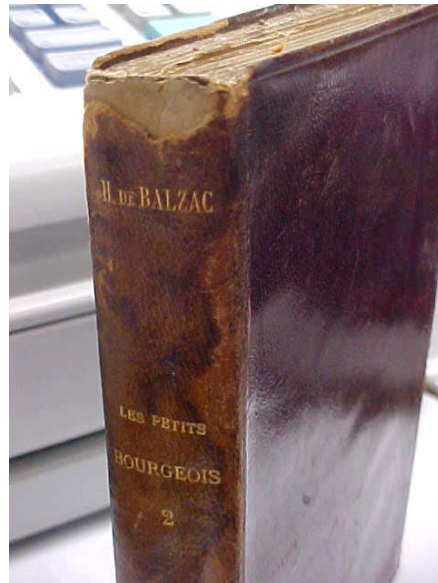

"Familien=Register" inserted between pp. 754 & [755]. Plates have been removed, and Family Register is disbound but present inside front cover. Kimber and Sharpless issued a number of German Bibles between 1827 and 1851. Only three have 975 pages: this undated edition, one edition dated 1830, and another dated 1833. This Bible, belonging to the Kaufman family whose records are penned in the registry, is printed in *fraktur*, and had a total of 40 plates. (Update: a Kaufman family representative indicates the plates were removed for display in the family farmhouse in Missouri.) Binding is leather, blackened at the top edge, apparently from long-term storage on the hearth or mantle of a fireplace.
